FIRST CROP 3-Y-O's IN 2023

James Garfield's first crop made a bright start in 2022 and saw him become the first freshman stallion to sire a Stakes winner when Maria Branwell took the Listed Coral National Stakes at Sandown.

David O'Meara's charge made it two from two in the five furlong sprint, and the form was boosted when the 104-rated runner-up Crispy Cat finished third in the Group 2 Norfolk Stakes. Maria Branwell went on to finish third in the Group 2 Queen Mary Stakes, which earned her an official rating of 100. Has had many three year olds in the winning enclosure this year (2023)

Lady Bullet (James Garfield) also won her first two starts and gained valuable black-type when finishing third in the Listed Blenheim Stakes won by Beauty Crescent (Acclamation).

MAN WITH THE PLAN (IRE) (Libourne Lod (IRE): Premio Criterium Varesino, Varese, L.)

James Garfield was a joint fourth in the GB & IRE freshman sires table based on black-type horses, despite having had less runners than those above him in the standings. His promising start with his first crop of two-year-olds his made all the more exciting given that he himself improved as a three-year old. His then two year olds now three year olds are acceleration to success. The Breeze up sales says it all.

The well-bred son of Exceed And Excel set a juvenile track record in the Group 2 Mill Reef Stakes. On his 3-Y-O return in the Group 3 Greenham Stakes, he ended the unbeaten run of Expert Eye the subsequent winner of the Breeders' Cup Mile. James Garfield himself was narrowly denied Group 1 glory close home in the Prix Maurice de Gheest, where five Group 1 winners chased him home.

James Garfield's fine start at stud was evident at the 2022 yearling sales, where his second crop were purchased by some of the shrewdest operators in the business incl. Joe Foley, Richard Knight, Sean Quinn, Clive Cox, Manor House Farm, Con Marnane, Peter Nolan, Noel Meade, etc.

James Garfield is by the Australian champion sire Exceed And Excel (Danehill), one of only six stallions to ever sire more than 200 stakes winners.

They include Helmet and Excelebration. The first-named is best known as the sire of the multiple Group 1 star and £12.6 million earner Thunder Snow, now at stud with Darley Japan, while Excelebration got the multiple Group 1 star and seven-figure earner Barney Roy

Rafha is also ancestress of classic-placed and Group 1-placed sprinter Gustav Klimt (Galileo) and classic star Mishriff (Make Believe), her full-sister El Jazirah is ancestress of Pinatubo (Shamardal) and Master Carpenter (Mastercraftsman), whereas halfsister Al Anood (Danehill) is the dam of Group 1 winner Pride Of Dubai (Street Cry).

Like James Garfield, they represent the mighty Danzig (Northern Dancer) sire line.
